# Industry Welcomes Port Hope's Newest Addition - Chemetron

## Town was also booming in 1853

From The Guide, July 30, 1853

With our last issue we think we concluded our cursory enumeration of the larger manufactories in our town, and we shall this week occupy ourselves more particularly with the splendid new brick buildings now in process of

erection upon our main street, and the dwelling houses which are springing up like plants in a nursery in every direction around our suburbs. We speak within the bounds of reality when we say that there are upwards of 200 new homes in the course of erection within the limits of Port Hope at the present time, all of

which are already engaged; and still we have heard several persons, who have lately made their home here, complain of difficulty in obtaining houses. The new dwelling houses which are so rapidly springing up around us are all of a good description, being principally neat brick and plastered frame cottages,

with a basement being put up, now a few old and middle aged ones have been thoroughly repaired this summer, and now appear in an entire new suit.

Mr. Gillett expects to have his building enclosed by the first of October, and fully completed early in the ensuing spring. Mr. Wilson's building, situate on the corner of Walton and Ontario Streets, will also be four stories high and will contain three large and commodious stores. and a good part of the woodwork has been commenced; the building will be completed this fall. The stores are already engaged.

Preparations are being made to build upon the vacant lot between the Upper Canada and Commercial Banks - which when completed will form another link of the chain of fine three storey buildings which line both sides of our main street.

## Bruins looking for second victory

CHICAGO (CP) - The way Milt Schmidt looks at it, he has a streak going and he would like to extend it tonight.

Milt is general manager of Boston Bruins, who topped Chicago Black Hawks 6-3 Sunday. The victory gave the visitors a 1-0 lead in the best-of-seven encounter for the playoff championship of the National Hockey League's East Division.

Schmidt was a part of the famed Kraut Line for the Bruins, sharing the distinction with Woody Dumart and Bobby Bauer.

"I played my last game right here in Chicago," Milt said Monday. "I recall we won it, but don't ask me the score."

"That sounds like you've got a win streak of two games," a Chicago reporter remarked. "Could be," Milt said. "Glad you look at it that way. Maybe we can stretch it a little."

Boston took the home-ice advantage away from the Hawks with their Sunday punch. After tonight's game, the series switches to Boston for two games.

### STARS HAD REST

Both teams worked out Monday but both excused their stars from action, although the goalies worked.

Cheever has won five of the six playoff games he has appeared in this season while Johnston lost his only start. For the Hawks, it will likely be Tony Zero, the Chicago nickname for Tony Esposito, who was in goal for the Sunday game and suffered his worst shellacking since Minnesota North Stars bombed him for

eight goals last December. Tony counted 15 shutouts during the regular season, a modern record. His backup man is Gerry Desjardins.

**RAPS DEFENSIVE PLAY**  
Billy Reay didn't single out Esposito for criticism, but said "We played the roughest

game defensively we played all year."

"Hard work is what put us where we are and we didn't have it from everybody on Sunday."

Esposito's particular cross Sunday was brother Phil, who scored three of the Bruins' six goals.

And it was Phil, expressing concern over the fact that his brother was hit on the temple by a puck early in the game, who got off the best line of the series so far.

"I hate to see anyone hurt," Phil said, "especially my brother."

Then, he added: "After all, blood is thicker than water."

**Red Baron remembered**  
BERLIN AP - The Red Baron made his fatal mistake 52 years ago.

Violating his own dictum, he let an enemy fighter plane get behind and above him.

When Manfred von Richthofen climbed into his all-red German Fokker triplane that day, he already was a legend. With 80 confirmed kills, the Red Baron, so named because of the distinctive color of his plane, would go down as the leading ace of the First World War.

He was after kill No. 81, a Canadian flying low over British lines, when another Canadian Capt. A. Roy Brown, of Carleton Place, Ontario, did him in. He was 25. The date: April 21, 1918, in the last year of the war.

For the anniversary a large wreath will appear at his grave in Berlin. Von Richthofen's memory is celebrated by flowers sent anonymously to the Invaliden Street Cemetery in East Berlin.

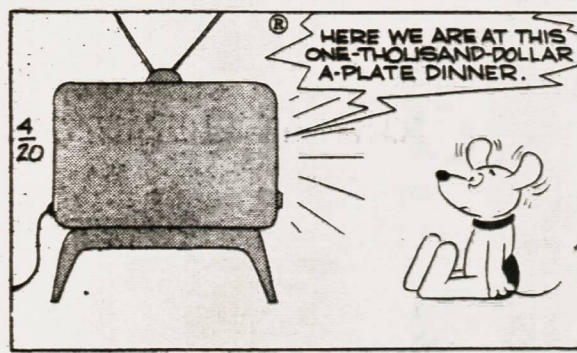
